There are several different forms used when talking about the future.

This work sheet focuses on the use of „will“:

„will“ remains the same for each person

„will“ can be shortened to „ ‘ll“ when used in conjunction with another word.

I ‘ll be in the office tomorrow.

He ‘ll play tennis next week.

We ‘ll win the game.

For negations you use „won ‘t“.

„Will not“ is only used when something should be emphasised.

I won ‘t be in the office tomorrow.

He won ‘t play tennis next week.

We won ‘t win the game.
